Comments/Questions

The following items were discussed with residents at the public informational meeting held on April 16, 2020.

1. Simon Wirth, 218.491.3575, is the Public Works Director and can be contacted regarding questions on the project. Simon will contact the engineer or the contractor if needed.
2. Resident at 205 Quamwell Ave S note that they have an electric dog fence and asked if grading would be occurring in their yard.
 - a. Electric dog fences and other private lines won't be marked with the other utilities.
 - b. Residents should mark the locations of any private lines, including electric dog fences, such that the contractor is aware of the location.
3. Resident at 204 Quality Ave asked if tree clearing would be happening on their property.
 - a. The row of trees on the property will not be removed but clearing along the right-of-way south of the property will be performed.
4. Resident at 204 Quality Ave noted that their internet line runs from the pole near STA 34+40 LT and runs to their home.
 - a. The contractor, MPM, is now aware of the line and will verify that it was located in the field.
5. Resident at 645 Quality asked if lighting improvements would still be completed and if curb would be added on the curve near Quality Lane.
 - a. Some existing lights will be replaced and other lighting added along the project.
 - b. Curb will be installed along the curve in an effort to keep vehicles on the road.
6. Resident asked how close the infiltration area will be to the playground in Humpries Park.
 - a. It was estimated that the pond bottom would be 50' from the playground.
7. Resident asked why the project stopped at the north end at Quality Lane and does not extend to 8th Street N.
 - a. Funds are not available for that section at this time.
 - b. That section of roadway was reconstructed more recently than the current project section.
 - c. There is no current schedule for that section of road to be completed.
 - d. City Hall can be notified of potholes that need to be repaired.
8. Questions were asked regarding the proposed schedule.

- a. Work will begin on Monday 4/20 and the current completion date is the beginning of August.
- b. The first layer of pavement is scheduled for the end of June.
- c. The contractor's detailed schedule was shared for those online.

Approximately 15 people attended the Quality Ave Informational Meeting.

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
