

I-94 Hwy 120/Century Avenue to the St. Croix River Oakdale, Woodbury, Landfall, Lake Elmo, Afton and Lakeland

Starting in the fall of 2022, I-94 between Hwy 120/Century Avenue and the St. Croix River will undergo a pavement improvement construction project. The work will improve safety, traffic flow and ride smoothness. Construction will be split into two stages with the majority of the work happening in 2023 and 2024.

Schedule

Fall 2022 – late fall 2024

Summary of Work

- Reinforce shoulders for temporary travel lanes
- Resurface pavement and ramps
- Construct new eastbound lane from I-494 to Woodbury Drive
- Install median barrier, replace signage, upgrade lighting and improve drainage
- Resurface and upgrade bicycle accessibility on frontage road (Hudson Road)
- Build two noise walls

Estimated Cost

\$120 million

Traffic Impacts

Mid-Summer through Fall 2022:

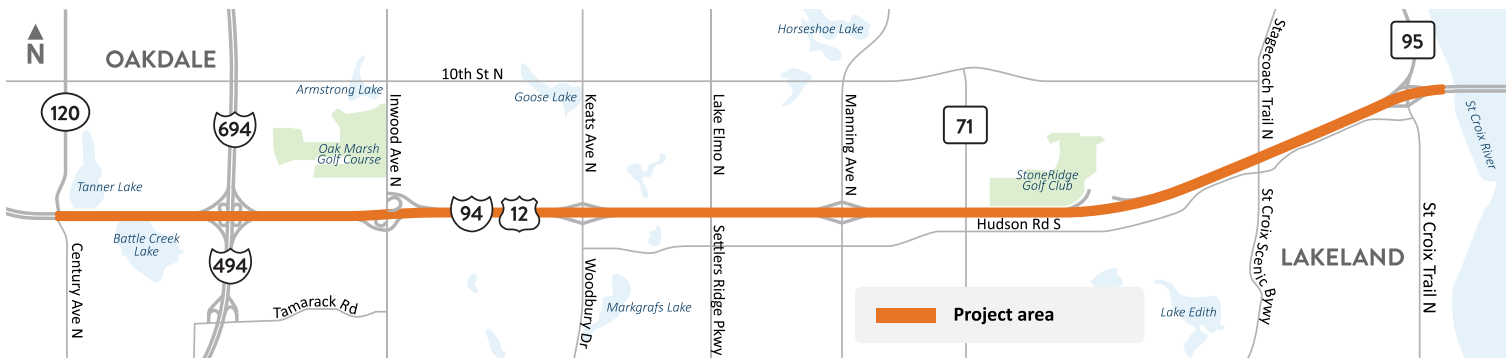
- Eastbound I-94 will be reduced to two travel lanes between Woodbury Drive and the St. Croix River

Spring through Fall 2023:

- I-94 will be reduced to two travel lanes in each direction between Woodbury Drive and the St. Croix River
- Several I-94 on/off ramps will be closed for one month between Woodbury Drive and the St. Croix River (*Note: No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time*)

Spring through Fall 2024:

- I-94 will be reduced to three travel lanes in each direction between Century Avenue and Woodbury Drive
- Several I-94 on/off ramps will be closed for one month between Century Avenue and Woodbury Drive (*Note: No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time*)
- I-694 on/off ramps at the I-94/I-494/I-694 Interchange will be closed and traffic detoured for part of the construction season
